The NIHR BioResource Exeter team are based within the NIHR Exeter Clinical Research Facility (Exeter CRF). The Exeter CRF is a joint venture between the Royal Devon and Exeter NHS Foundation Trust (RD&E) and the University of Exeter and was set up to facilitate Translational and Mechanistic Clinical Research.



The NIHR BioResource Exeter team have extensive experience in both developing the infrastructure necessary for setting up and running large scale studies, and in recruitment and sample collection. They have previously successfully recruited to a number of disease specific studies and cohorts both locally and nationally. While initially focusing on generic healthy volunteer recruits, the Exeter team will extend this to include a disease specific Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) cohort and a Mental Health service cohort.
